



Health Occupation Basic Entrance Test (HOBET-V) Information

The HOBET-V is a computerized test that primarily evaluates Math skills and Reading Comprehension. The HOBET-V is required for acceptance into certain health programs at Southeast Tech. Applicants are only allowed three (3) attempts to pass the HOBET-V test. Passing scores for the HOBET test are the following:

- 2-Year Health Programs: Math Score (62), Reading Score (73)
- 1-Year Health Programs: Math Score (55), Reading Score (65)

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- There is a **\$50.00 fee** for the test.
- This test is offered every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday and also two Saturdays a month. You must register and pay online at <http://testing.southeasttech.edu>.
- Students outside of South Dakota may contact the Southeast Tech Testing Center at (605) 367-6014 to set-up proctored testing arrangements in alternate testing locations.
- If you are being asked to take the COMPASS exam, it should be done prior to the HOBET.

TESTING DAY DETAILS:

- The test is located in the **Testing Center** in **Room 121** of the **George Mickelson Building** at Southeast Technical Institute.
- Please arrive 15 minutes early and have the following available when you arrive for the test:
 - 1) **Driver's License or State ID**
 - 2) **Social Security Number** or Social Security card (*If you do not have these, please contact 605.367.6048 before the testing date.*)
- The test is timed and takes approximately **2 hours**. Calculators are not permitted for the test.
