To provide the School Board with an overview of Sioux Falls School District high school graduates enrolled at Southeast Tech.

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Graduates from the Sioux Falls School District make up an average of 22.6% of Southeast Tech's overall student population. By delving deeper into the data, Southeast Tech has found some interesting fact that may help guide the Institute and the District as we continue to build a stronger partnership to assure that high school students receive maximum educational benefits at a lower cost, as well as meet the regional workforce needs of Sioux Falls and the surrounding region.

# Overall Enrollment

Over the past three years, Sioux Falls School District Graduates:

- ▶ Accounted for 24.1% of Southeast Tech's overall fall enrollments
  - ▶ Fall 18 513\*
  - ▶ Fall 17 556
  - ▶ Fall 16 552

# Directly After High School



Over the past three years, Sioux Falls School District Graduates attending Southeast Tech directly out of high school:

- ▶ Accounted for an average of 24.2% of overall students coming directly from high school (increase from 23.9% to 24.5%)
- ▶ Increased from 78 to 97 students
- ▶ Came from Roosevelt and Washington High School (73.2% Fall 18)
  - ▶ Lincoln High School: 15.5%
  - ▶ New Tech High School: 11.3%

# Dual Credit

Over the past three years, Sioux Falls School District Dual Credit Students:

- ▶ Accounted for 31% of all Dual credit students
- ▶ Dropped from 162 in Fall 16 to 126 in Fall 18\*
- ▶ Roosevelt and New Tech account for 100% of enrollments

\*Learners to Leaders discontinued

# Delayed Enrollment

Sioux Falls School District Graduates who delayed their enrollment (not directly out of high school) and were new to Southeast Tech for Fall 18:

- ▶ 98 students delayed entry
  - ▶ 49% transferred-in to Southeast Tech (prior college experience)
  - ▶ 51% first time (no prior college experience)
- ▶ 25.5% were Fall 17 graduates with most first time
- ▶ Beyond one year of high school graduation:
  - ▶ 63% transferred- in to Southeast Teach
  - ▶ 37% first time
