

The TEAS-V is a computerized test that primarily evaluates math skills and reading comprehension. The TEAS-V is required for acceptance into certain health programs at Southeast Tech. Applicants are only allowed three attempts to pass the TEAS-V test, except for LPN students. LPN applicants are only allowed two attempts. Also, 30 days must pass before taking the TEAS exam a second time. Passing scores for the TEAS test are as follows:

Cardiac Sonography, DMS, Invasive Cardiovascular, Vascular Sonography	Math: 62; Reading: 73
LPN, Veterinary Technician	Math: 62; Reading: 75
Paramedic Science, Surgical Technology	Math: 55; Reading: 65

### GENERAL INFORMATION

- There is a \$79 fee for the test.
- This test is offered every multiple times each week. You must register and pay online at [testing.southeasttech.edu](http://testing.southeasttech.edu)
- If you cannot travel to Southeast Tech for this exam, please contact the Testing Center at 605-367-6014 to set up proctored testing arrangements in another location.
- If you need to take the Next Generation Accuplacer exam, it should be done before you take the TEAS exam.

### TESTING DAY DETAILS

- The Testing Center is located in Room 103 of the Ed Wood Center at Southeast Tech.
- Please arrive 15 minutes early and have an ID card with you.
- This is a timed test and takes approximately two hours. Scratch paper and pencils are provided for you. There is a built-in calculator within the exam for you to use.
