The TEAS-V is a computerized test that primarily evaluates math skills and reading comprehension. The TEAS is required for acceptance into certain health programs at Southeast Technical College. Applicants are only allowed three attempts to pass the TEAS-V test. Also, 30 days must pass before taking the TEAS exam a second time. Passing scores for the TEAS test are as follows:

Veterinary Technician	Math: 62; Reading: 75

- This test is offered multiple times each week. You must register and pay online at testing.southeasttech.edu.
- If you cannot travel to Southeast Tech for this exam, please contact the Testing Center at 605-367-6014 to set up proctored testing arrangements at another location.
- If you need to take the Next Generation Accuplacer exam, it should be done before you take the TFAS exam.

TESTING DAY DETAILS

- The Testing Center is located in Room 103 of the Ed Wood Center at Southeast Tech.
- Please arrive 15 minutes early and have an ID card with you.
- This is a timed test and takes approximately two hours. Scratch paper and pencils are provided for you. There is a built-in calculator within the exam for you to use.
