Availability of Information

The Higher Education Act of 1965 (HEA), as amended, requires schools participating in the Title IV financial aid programs to provide an annual notice to students and employees disclosing a wide range of consumer information. The purpose of this information is to help students and employees make informed decisions regarding their education or employment.

Completion, Graduation, Transfer, Retention, Placement Rates, & Student Body Diversity

Information on rates for full-time, first-time degree – or certificate -seeking students.

Graduation Rate – STC tracks the progress of students who began their studies as full-time, first-time degree- or certificate-seeking students to determine if the degree or certificate is completed within 150% of the normal time that is expected for program completion.

Retention Rate – These rates represent the first to second year retention rates of first-time degree-seeking students as calculated by IPEDS.

Information on Campus Crime and Fire Safety

Campus Security Report – Policies, procedures, and crime statistics reported from the last three years at Southeast Technical College are published through the Annual Security Report. The Annual Security Report is a guide for how STC reports crimes and works to prevent crimes, sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking. Arrests, disciplinary actions, drug and liquor violations and illegal weapons possession are all included in the Annual Security Report.
