Reporting Child Abuse/Child Protection

Southeast Technical College recognizes the incidence of child abuse and neglect among children and youth. Abuse and neglect may have a serious effect on the education of children and youth. Southeast Tech urges that reasonable steps to deal with the problem be taken by Southeast Tech professional staff members.

South Dakota Codified Law mandates that school personnel having reasonable cause to suspect that any child under the age of 18 years has been abused or neglected shall report or cause reports to be made in accordance with the provisions of the law and Regulation STC 937.1.
