Re: CARES Relief Funds

Dear STUDENT NAME,

In May you applied identifying financial impacts as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic that affected your educational plans at Southeast Technical College. Specifically, you identified additional expenses in one or more areas that included the following: food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, or childcare.

Under legislation enacted by Congress and signed by the President, the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act authorized institutions of higher education to distribute cash grants to students as part of the funding allocated in the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF).

Southeast initially estimated that approximately 1,700 students would be eligible to apply for relief. At that level of participation, the average cash grant would have been roughly \$500 per eligible student.

The actual number of applications received was considerably less than initially anticipated with fewer than 400 applications submitted. As a result of receiving fewer applications than first thought, Southeast has the discretion to increase the cash grant amounts from our HEERF funds.

On the back of this letter, information from your original application and your potential cash grant is reflected. As part of the process of distributing the funds to you, we are requiring that you review the information provided, and sign the document confirming your financial impact. The document should be signed by you and returned to Southeast Technical College in the enclosed self-addressed postage paid envelope. **Electronic submissions will not be accepted.**

Funds will be distributed on a weekly basis; however, this document must be returned before November 30, 2020 to ensure the full amount of your cash grant as reflected on the reverse side of this document.
